

# OFFICE OF THE UNITED STATES TRADE REPRESENTATIVE IMPOSES SECTION 301 TARIFFS ON CERTAIN CHINESE IMPORTED GOODS

On July 17, 2018, the U.S. Trade Representative (Trade Representative) provided notice to take action in the form of an additional 10 percent *ad valorem* duty on products of China with an annual trade value of approximately \$200 billion - the HTSUS subheadings for these products are set forth in what is known as List 3. Effective September 24, 2018, the additional 10 percent *ad valorem* duty was imposed on List 3 products. Effective May 10, 2019, the Trade Representative increased the *ad valorem* duty on List 3 products from 10 percent to 25 percent. The below link to the Final Rule from the Trade Representative's website provides detailed information on this duty increase:

On January 15, 2020, the United States and China signed the Phase One Trade Agreement. The 25% Section 301 U.S. tariff on List 3 products, including power supplies and power cords, remain in effect:

As the products that CONDOR ELECTRONICS imports from China have been impacted by the aforementioned Section 301 tariffs, normal stock levels and pricing for CONDOR products has changed.
